² During thesis sessions and graduation days lectures will not be suspended but, if necessary, they will take place online.

The approval to the extraordinary exam session of the winter session reserved to ingoing and outgoing students has now been suspended.

Mid term exams are held from 21 to 25 November 2022, and from 26 April to 3 May 2023.

Mid term exams are not allowed for 6 credit courses, instead they are optional for 9 credit courses for Bachelor's degrees and Master's degrees.

Mid term exams are compulsory for 12 credit courses, except that faculty Directors may provide specific derogations for these courses if justified by the professor in charge (or assignee of the course) with reference to the characteristics of the course, organization of teaching, methods of teaching and other parameters that are useful for the evaluation.

The previously scheduled proclamations on 4 and 5 May 2023 will take place during the graduation sessions of March and April 2023. During the graduation sessions of March and April 2023 classes will be suspended for both Bachelor's degree and Master's degree programs.

The periods for intermediate tests are scheduled from 24 to 25 November 2022; and from 3 to 4 May 2023. During the intermediate tests of 3 and 4 May 2023, classes will be suspended for both the three-year and master's degree courses.
